ORDER


Now on this 18th day of May 2010, this case comes on for consideration on Respondent and Counter-Claimant Southwest Casino and Hotel Corporation's ("Southwest") Motion to Reopen Proceedings to Award Fees and Costs. Based upon all of the files, records, and proceedings herein, and being fully advised in the premises,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED

1. Claimants and Counter-Respondents Cheyenne-Arapaho Tribes (the "Tribe") shall pay Southwest \$1,176,367.28 in attorneys' fees and costs, to be added to the \$490,182.00 in damages previously awarded to Southwest, for a total award of \$1,666,549.28;
2. Interest shall accrue on the \$1,666,549.28 award at four percent (4%) per annum from September 23, 2009;
3. The Tribe shall pay by wire transfer to the trust account of Gray, Plant, Mooty,


said award in twelve equal monthly installments commencing on June 15, 2010, of \$145,547.13.
