## CAMP & CLINIC ASSISTANCE

### GUIDELINES

The following are a list of the guidelines that the R.E.Sp.E.C.T. Tribal Program will use to help assist our youth in participating in a recreational, exercise and/or sport league or association, which will ensure their success of attaining the skills and attributes to compete at a higher level.

1. Priority will be given to enrolled members of the Cheyenne & Arapaho Tribes of Oklahoma.
2. All applications must include a Certified Degree of Indian Blood for each applicant.
3. R.E.Sp.E.C.T. will assist students/participants who are enrolled in Pre-K to incoming Seniors for the next school year.
4. Allowance will be on a (3) three times per student, per year basis of up to two hundred (\$200.00) for Day Camps, and three hundred dollars (\$300.00) for Overnight Boarding Camps, to be used towards an accredited camp or clinic in their respective sport or recreation of choice.
5. Checks will be made out directly to the organization that is conducting the camp or clinic, NOT to the parents, guardian or participant.
6. All completed applications will need to be turned into the R.E.Sp.E.C.T. Program Office two weeks prior to the deadline of the selected camp or clinic. Completed applications will include: camp or clinic brochure/flyer, vendor name & address and a copy of the CDIB
7. All participants/applicants will be responsible for the remainder of the camp fees, meals, transportation...etc., associated with the camp of clinic.
8. Participant and parent/guardian must sign the R.E.Sp.E.C.T. Program "Sportsmanship Creed and Parents Creed," and conduct themselves accordingly throughout the camp/clinic.
9. Participants must agree to complete the entire camp or clinic, if they do not, they will not be eligible to apply for any assistance for one entire year.
