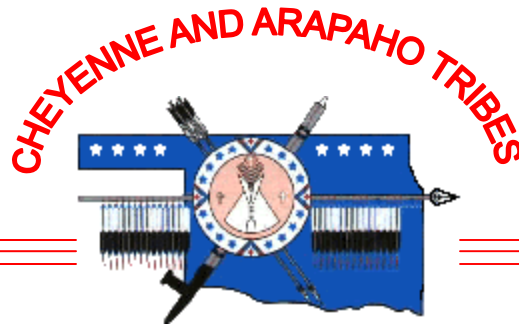

## **Crisis Assistance Application Process**

**Basic Requirement:** Enrolled Adult member of the Cheyenne and Arapaho Tribe  
A completed application

**Step By Step:**

- Contact the Crisis Assistance Program staff or access the internet at [c-a-tribes.org](http://c-a-tribes.org) to obtain information and an application.
- Read and complete each question on the application.
- Return completed application with all documentation to the Crisis Assistance office in order to schedule an assessment with a caseworker. This may be done in the following ways:  
**You must contact the office to verify that the application and documentation were received.**  
When you have verified items have been received, you may request a phone interview.
- Completed applications may be returned on **M, T, W, TH, F** mornings to the Crisis Assistance office for a walk in assessment appointment.  
**SPACE IS LIMITED.** Nine (9) clients are seen each day on a first come first serve basis. Applications may also be received by the outreach caseworkers.

**Only after verification of crisis and unmet need are determined by a caseworker can services be determined. Disbursement of assistance is given after applicants are approved for services. Most assistance not requiring a check can be given the same day if before 4:00 PM. Anyone who has been denied services may submit a new application with proper documentation or may write a statement requesting reconsideration and a reason why.**
